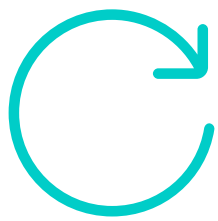

Additional Details:

- **The schedule** repeats weekly for the duration of your program
- **Shadowing** typically lasts about 5 hours per day and takes place with the available healthcare professionals in the assigned department, so you'll also have scheduled free time for lunch and other activities during the weekdays.
- **There are typically two students** shadowing in each department at a time. Sample shadowing rotations are available on the next page.
- **Your City Manager** organizes Weekly Group Outings (including a group lunch) which could be something like a hike, a cultural excursion, or a visit to a nearby city.
- **Group meals** (dinner) take place twice a week.
- **Your rotation schedule** will be shared once you arrive on-program. Rotations are shared weekly and will outline the departments for the upcoming week.

Sample Rotation Schedule

Students rotate through a different specialty, typically on a weekly basis. Each student's schedule is designed to include exposure to a direct patient care department, an indirect patient care department, and—when available at the shadowing hospital—a specialty indicated on the Pre-Departure Form.

Please note that while preferences for specialties are not guaranteed, the majority of Atlantis students receive at least one of their selected choices as indicated on the Pre-Departure Form, which is completed and submitted to the Post-Enrollment Team prior to the start of the program. Once rotations have been assigned, students will not be able to make changes to their placement.

Below are three sample rotation schedules for a six-week program.
